

Foreword

The YunoJuno 2024 Freelancer Rates Report, based on 98,000+ contracts, reveals that despite the challenging economic conditions in 2023, freelance rates remained stable overall. Average day rates continued to increase in many disciplines, albeit at a slower pace than in previous years. However, certain sectors experienced a drop in rates as freelancers and companies swiftly adapted to the changing business environment. The report underscores the resilience of freelancers and the flexibility of the freelance market in responding to economic uncertainties, with variations in rates reflecting the diverse impact on different industries and skill sets.

Coming into 2024, we are seeing many companies ramping up their flexible freelance workforce again, as a preferred way to get projects moving with highly skilled workers, without increasing permanent headcount.

As demand increases in this economic environment, freelancers prove to be the most flexible, adaptable and resilient part of a company's workforce. That's why we believe, freelancers and contractors are the future of work.

It's been inspiring for us at YunoJuno to see how the freelancers on our platform have used the increased downtime between projects in 2023 to upskill and thus increase their value to future clients by training themselves in Al and other emerging tools and technologies. As the demand for their services increases, we expect these highly skilled freelancers to deliver a step change in productivity to the companies who take a strategic approach to their flexible workforce and utilise the power and efficiency of freelancers to gain a competitive advantage.

Methodology



Data

The data from this report is drawn from approximately 287,000+ freelance records on the YunoJuno platform from the full calendar years from 2021 – 2023. This year we have included data for bookings, applications and approvals in order to give the report additional depth and insight into all of our freelancers.

Note: All charts contain all the records, apart from booking related charts that only contain booking data.

All client and freelancer comments and quotes are from active participants within the YunoJuno network.

Operating as a global company, our clients collaborate with contractors from over 150 countries. While our expansive reach spans the globe, for simplicity, we'll reference currency in £, reflecting our roots in London.

Glossary

Year-on-year growth: Calculated the yearly growth from 2021 -2023.

Average day rates: Calculated by compounding roles relevant to each industry and calculating the average rate charged.

Average contract booking length: Calculated by compounding roles relevant to each industry and measuring the average length of each successful booking.

Synopsis

2023 marked an average year-on-year increase of approximately +0.1% in day rates for freelancers, reaching an average of £379 per day. Across all disciplines, the average project length stood at 24 working days, translating to just under 5 weeks. This was a -0.8% year-onyear decrease.

Notably, significant variations exist among disciplines, with the top-earning fields being Strategy (£497 average per day), Market Research (£488) and Data (£473). In terms of project lengths, Client Services boasted the longest average, with freelancers being booked for just over 9 weeks (46 working days).

This report delves into the day rates across 15 disciplines on the YunoJuno platform, highlighting common day rate ranges, overall averages, and a breakdown by experience. Each category is accompanied by data on project lengths, exploring the most prevalent roles within those disciplines, their average rates, and contract lengths.

Average Day Rates

From a comprehensive dataset encompassing 98,000+ bookings, applications and approvals, spanning across various disciplines, experience levels and contract lengths, the 2023 average day rate stood at £379, reflecting a +0.1% year-on-year increase.

Ranking within the top 10% across industries exhibits some variability, but, on average, contracts earned approximately £647 per day, marking a +0.5% year-on-year increase.



Average Contact Lengths

The average project length **decreased slightly by -0.8%** to **24 working days**. This expanded dataset provides enhanced depth and insight into our freelancers' engagement. In 11 out of the **15 disciplines**, there was a decrease in average contract length.

Contracts within the top 10% not only experienced a notable increase compared to the average, but also secured engagements that were **+250% longer** than the norm. However, there was a decline of **-2.5% year-on-year**.













Day Rate

Freelancers in Client Services earned an average day rate of £357, showcasing a +2% year-on-year increase. Top 10% contracts earned an average of £653 per day, marking a slight -5% decrease year-on-year.



Director-level roles experienced a year-on-year **decrease of -13%**, contrasting with increases observed in other roles compared to 2022. **Midweight** roles saw the highest increase on their average rates, at **+13% year-on-year**.

Contract Length and Bookings

In 2023, the average contract length was **46 working days (9 weeks)**, a **year-on-year decrease of -22%**, meaning it was one of the highest drops across the disciplines. Top 10% contracts averaged **72 working days**, reflecting a **-17% decrease year-on-year**.

There was a decrease in contract lengths across all experience levels. **Director** levels experienced the highest of **-30% year-on-year**.

Client Services saw peaks in demand observed every 3 months, with March seeing the highest bookings in 2023. **Bookings** within **Client Services** experienced a growth of **+17% year-on-year**.









Roles

Client Services Directors, on average commanded the highest rate among roles within Client Services, earning £891 per day. Business Developers secured the longest contract lengths, working 59 working days.


Day Rate

Creative freelancers earned an average day rate of £391, a slight decrease of -2% year-on-year. The top 10% contracts earned an average of £639 per day, a +1% year-on-year increase.



Among Creatives, **Midweight** roles experienced a **+6% increase** in 2023, while **Director** level roles saw a **decrease of -7% year-on-year**.

Average day rate by experience










Contract Length and Bookings

The average contract length was 20 working days (4 weeks) in 2023, a year-on-year decrease of -11%. Top 10% contracts averaged 89 working days (18 weeks), showing no year-on-year change.

Contract lengths experienced a decrease across all experience levels, with **Senior** and **Midweight** roles witnessing the most decline at **-13% year-on-year**.

Bookings within the **Creatives** sector saw a remarkable growth, **increasing by +44% year-on-year**. Demand for Creatives was consistent throughout 2023, with August seeing the highest bookings in 2023.


The average day rate across the Data sector was £473 per day, a decrease of -4% year-on-year. Top 10% contracts also experienced a -8% decrease with an average rate of £623.

Midweight and Director roles saw decreases at -16% and -14%, respectively, year-on-year. Whilst Lead roles saw a +4% year-on-year increase.

Contract Length and Bookings

In 2023, the average contract length was **39 working days (just under 10 weeks)**, a **year-on-year decrease of -15%**. Top 10% contracts averaged **93 working days (just under 19 weeks)**, reflecting a **year-on-year increase of +1%**.

Midweight roles saw a notable increase of +38%, with Director roles having no year-on-year change. Lead and Senior roles witnessed a decrease, with Lead role seeing a substantial drop at -32%.

Experiencing a surge, **Data bookings increased by +39% year-on-year**, demonstrating sustained demand throughout the majority of the year, with April observing the highest bookings in 2023. However, a notable shift occurred in the last quarter, marked by a decrease in demand.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)









Day Rate

In the Design sector, the average day rate was £355 per day, reflecting an increase of +2% year-on-year. Whilst top 10% contracts experienced a +1% increase with an average rate of £615.



Midweight and Senior roles witnessed increases of +17% and +2%, respectively, year-on-year. However, Lead and Director roles saw decreases of -4% and -2%, respectively.

Contract Length and Bookings

In 2023, the average contract length was 17 working days (just over 3 weeks), marking a year-on-year decrease of -4%. Top 10% contracts averaged 84 working days (just under 17 weeks), reflecting a year-on-year increase of +3%.

Midweight and Senior roles experienced increases of +17% and +2%, respectively, across their contract lengths. Lead and Director roles saw a decrease year-on-year, with declines of -14% and -5%, respectively.

Bookings within **Design increased +27% year-on-year**. Demand remained consistent, with clients regularly requiring designers throughout 2023 with May being the highest booking month in 2023.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)









Day Rate

The average day rate in the Developer discipline was £414 per day, indicating a slight decrease of -1% year-on-year. Top 10% contracts, didn't experience a change, with an average rate of £626 per day.



All experience levels, except Midweight roles witnessed a decrease in their average day rates, with **Director** Roles experiencing a notable **decline of -15% year-on-year**. **Midweight** roles saw **no year-on-year change**.

Contract Length and Bookings

The Developer discipline stood out as one of the few experiencing a year-on-year increase in contract lengths. Contracts averaged 38 working days (just under 8 weeks), marking a notable increase of +7%. However, top 10% contracts averaged 92 working days (just over 18 weeks), reflecting a marginal year-on-year decrease of -2%.

Across all experience levels, except **Director** which saw **no change**, increased in contract length. Both **Midweight** and **Senior** roles saw the highest **year-on-year increase at +6%**.

The **Development** sector witnessed an uptick in **bookings**, experiencing a **+9% year-on-year increase**. There was an increase in demand observed during the first quarter of the year. Despite fluctuations, demand remained relatively stable for the remainder of the year, with March being the highest booking month of 2023.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)













Day Rate

Film & Motion stood out as the sole discipline to witness a year-on-year increase in both average day rates and contract lengths. The average day rate in Film & Motion was £375 per day, reflecting a notable +3% increase year-on-year. Similarly, the Top 10% contracts also experienced an increase of +1% year-on-year, settling at an average rate of £685 per day.



Across all experience levels, except **Director** roles which saw a **-1% decrease**, there were increases in their average day rates. **Midweight** roles experienced an **increase of +8% year-on-year**.


Contract Length and Bookings

Contracts within the discipline averaged 11 working days (2 weeks), year-on-year increase of +8%. Top 10% contracts, on the other hand, averaged 79 working days (just under 16 weeks), reflecting a year-on-year increase of +7%.

All experience levels saw increases in their contract lengths, with **Midweight** roles seeing the highest **year-on-year increase at +30**%.

Bookings within the **Film & Motion** sector **increased by +19% year-on-year**. The sector experienced heightened demand, particularly in the first half of the year, with March being the highest booking month of 2023. There was a noticeable tapering off of demand in the latter part of the year.



In the Film & Motion discipline, **Videography** emerged with the highest average rate across roles, earning on average £417 per day. On the other hand, **Producers** secured the longest contract, surpassing the average within the by +209% (34 v 11 working days on average).






Day Rate

In 2023, Market Research claimed the second highest average day rate on the YunoJuno platform, earning £488 per day, although it marked a year-on-year decrease of -3%. The top 10% averaged at £710 per day however, saw a -10% year-on-year decrease.



Midweight roles saw a notable +36% increase year-on-year, with both Senior and Lead roles also experiencing increases. However, Director roles saw a -4% decrease year-on-year.


Contract Length and Bookings

Market Research stood out among disciplines, experiencing substantial growth in contract length with a remarkable year-on-year increase of +27%, averaging 40 working days (8 weeks). Top 10% contracts averaged 104 working days (just under 21 weeks), reflecting a year-on-year increase of +12%.


Lead and Director levels saw notable increases in contract rates, growing by +58% and +2% year-on-year, respectively. Whereas, Senior and Midweight roles saw a decrease, with Midweight experiencing a -42% decrease year-on-year.

However, despite these trends, overall **bookings** within **Market Research** saw a **decrease of -6% year-on-year**. Slight peaks in booking demand were observed every two to three months with the highest booking month of 2023 being January.


Day Rate

In 2023, Marketing witnessed a **-3% year-on-year decrease** with an average day rate of **£346**. In contrast, the top 10% experienced a **+4% increase**, averaging **£688 per day**.



Midweight roles showed a +17% year-on-year increase. Whilst the other experience levels showed a decrease, with Lead roles showing the biggest decrease of -5% year-on-year.


In 2023, Marketing experienced a -12% decrease in the average contract length, settling at 41 working days (8 weeks). The top 10% contracts also saw a -3% decrease, averaging 83 working days (over 16 weeks).

Midweight roles stood out with a +11% increase in their contract lengths, while other experience levels witnessed a decrease. Director Roles saw the most significant decrease of -18% year-on-year.

The Marketing sector experienced robust growth, witnessing a remarkable +39% year-on-year increase in bookings. This upward trajectory in demand continued to gain momentum throughout the year with October being the highest booking month of 2023.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)








In 2023, Photography experienced a -13% year-on-year decrease with an average day rate of £465. Top 10% contracts didn't see a year-on-year change, staying at £831 per day.



All experience levels witnessed a decrease, with **Director** and **Senior** roles experiencing the highest declines at **-24**% and **-23**%, **respectively**.





Contract Length and Bookings

In 2023, Photography demonstrated the most significant increase in contract lengths across the YunoJuno platform, with a remarkable **+44% year-on-year** surge to an average of **9 working days**. However, the top 10% contracts witnessed a substantial **decrease of -31% year-on-year**, with the average contract length being **75 working days (15 weeks)**.

Encouragingly, all experience levels saw an increase in contract lengths, with **Directors** leading the way with a remarkable **+200%** surge.

Moreover, **Photography bookings** exhibited substantial growth by **+52% year-on-year**, with demand fluctuating every few months. The highest booking month of 2023 was May.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)










In 2023, PR was one of the few disciplines to experience an increase in rates. The average day rate was £395, a +3% year-on-year increase. Interestingly, the top 10% witnessed a -4% decrease year-on-year change, at £630 per day.



Director roles experienced a slight **decrease of -1%**, whereas **Midweight** roles observed the most significant **year-on-year increase at +68%**.

Contract Length and Bookings

In 2023, contract lengths on average decreased by -19% across PR, settling at 37 working days (just over 7 weeks). Similarly, top 10% contracts witnessed a -18% decrease, averaging 75 working days (15 weeks).

In 2023, all experience levels within PR experienced a decrease. Notably, **Senior** roles witnessed the most substantial **decrease at -31%**.

However, despite these fluctuations, **PR bookings** showed a positive **increase of +6% year-on-year**, with demand increasing in the second half of the year. October was the highest booking month in 2023.



Day Rate

Project Management experienced a modest decrease in day rates, **declining by -3%**, with freelancers earning an average of £400 per day. The top 10% also saw a **decrease of -2% year-on-year** averaging £632 per day.



Midweight roles exhibited an increase of +8% year-on-year, signalling positive growth. However, other experience levels faced a decrease, particularly with Senior Roles witnessing a decline of -5%.









Contract Length and Bookings

In 2023, average contract lengths in Project Management experienced a **decline of -19% year-on-year**, settling at **45 working days (9 weeks)**. Similarly, top 10% contracts witnessed a **-7% decrease**, averaging **83 working days (just under 17 weeks)**.

All experience levels saw a decrease in their contract lengths in 2023. Notably, **Senior** roles witnessed the most significant decline, experiencing a **-23% year-on-year decrease**.

Project Management demonstrated a contrasting trend with a notable **increase of +26% year-on-year in bookings**. Despite consistent demand throughout the year, the sector experienced a slight downturn in the last quarter. August was the highest booking month of 2023.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)











Project Directors commanded the highest rate, surpassing the discipline's average by an impressive **+42%**, earning **£578** per day. On the other hand, **Resource Managers** secured the longest contract lengths within the discipline, at **105** working days.




Day Rate

In 2023, freelancers in the social discipline earned an average of £334 per day, reflecting a -2% decrease year-on-year. Top 10% contracts also experienced a decrease of -2%, earning £680 per day.



Director and **Lead** roles in the social discipline both witnessed a **-4% year-on-year decrease** in their average day rates. However, Senior and Midweight roles experienced a positive increase, and notably, **Midweight** roles saw a significant **+14% increase year-on-year**.


The Social discipline experienced a **decrease of -8%** on contract lengths, with contracts lasting **35 working days on average (7 weeks)**. However, top 10% contracts showed a positive trend with a **+15% increase year-on-year**, securing contracts averaging **90 working days (18 weeks)**.

Director level roles saw a significant **+14% increase**, while other experience levels witnessed decreases, with **Senior** roles experiencing the most substantial **decline at -15%**.

Despite these fluctuations, **bookings** in the **Social** discipline displayed an increase of **+27**% **year-on-year**. Social saw their highest booking month in March in 2023 and further peaks every three months.

Within the Social discipline, **Social Media Managers** emerged as the top earners, at £375 per day. On the other hand, **Paid Social Specialists** secured the longest contracts, discipline's average by +71% (59 v 35 working days on average).




Day Rate

In 2023, Strategy freelancers led the way earning the highest average amount on the YunoJuno platform. Despite this, they saw a **-4% year-on-year decrease** in their average rate, earning **£497 per day**. However, the top 10% of contracts exhibited a positive trend with a **+2% increase**, earning **£672 per day**.



All experience levels across saw a decline in their average day rate, **Midweight** and **Lead** roles saw the biggest **year-on-year decrease of -5**%.





Contract Length and Bookings

The average contract length for Strategy freelancers was 31 working days (6 weeks), marking a year-on-year decrease of -17%. The top 10% contracts also experienced a decrease of -5%, with an average length of 80 working days (16 weeks).

Notably, all experience levels within the Strategy discipline saw a decrease in contract lengths, with **Midweight** level roles experiencing the most significant **drop at -34**%.

Despite the decline in contract lengths, **bookings** in the **Strategy** discipline increased by **+32% year-on-year**. Demand increased every 3 months, with July being the highest booking month in 2023.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)













Day Rate

In 2023, Studio freelancers experienced a positive trend in average day rates, with an **increase** of +7%, earning £314 per day on average. This was the highest increase across the 15 disciplines analysed. Notably, the top 10% contracts also saw a rise, with a +14% increase, earning £762 per day.


On the other hand, contract lengths exhibited a decline. Freelancers, on average, secured contracts for 11 days, reflecting a -28% year-on-year decrease. The top 10% also experienced a slight decrease of -1%, with the average being 99 working days (just under 20 weeks).

Across all experience levels in Studio, there was a decrease in contract lengths, averaging a **year-on-year decline of -39%**. **Midweight** level roles witnessed the most significant **decrease** at -57%.

Bookings in the **Studio** discipline **increased by +6% year-on-year**. Demand remained consistent throughout the year, with November being the highest booking month of 2023.

Monthly distribution of bookings by year (%)









Day Rate

In 2023, the UX discipline experienced a -14% decrease in average day rates, with freelancers earning £434 per day. Top 10% contracts within the discipline saw a -1% decrease, taking the average to £615 per day.



Experience levels across the UX discipline experienced a decrease, with **Lead** roles seeing the most **decline at -17% year-on-year**. On the other hand, **Midweight** roles witnessed a slight **increase of +1% year-on-year**.

Contract Length and Bookings

Across the UX discipline, contract lengths exhibited a decrease, with freelancers securing contracts for an average of **35 working days (7 weeks)**, marking a **-9% year-on-year decrease**. However, the top 10% of contracts saw a positive **increase of +7%**, with an average length of **90 working days (18 weeks)**.

In the UX discipline, most experience levels saw a decline in contract lengths, particularly **Lead** roles with the highest **decrease of -15%**. Conversely, **Midweight** roles experienced a positive **increase of +6%** in their average contract lengths.

Although **UX bookings** witnessed a **-25% decrease in 2023**, there was a noticeable pickup in demand within the second half of the year with both June and September being the highest booking months of 2023.









